Application for Recognition as dapaanz Kaumatua

The Purpose of dapaanz 'Kaumātua Recognition' is to acknowledge and recognise kaumātua who do not hold formal Addiction qualifications, but have made major contributions to the Addiction sector (primarily in voluntary roles).

Procedures

The kaumātua/person is nominated by a dapaanz registered addiction practitioner/member, and the local iwi/hapū or a recognised iwi/hapū urban authority.

The application for recognition is submitted jointly by the person applying, the dapaanz registered practitioner/member, and the local iwi/hapū or recognised iwi/hapū authority. Support letters must be provided from the dapaanz member and iwi/hapū/authority.

Applications will go to the dapaanz Matua subcommittee for consideration.

Recognition

Kaumātua with dapaanz Recognition, are acknowledged by dapaanz as contributing significantly to addiction recovery. Recognition entitles the kaumātua to membership of dapaanz and complementary attendance at its functions, eg. Cutting Edge.

How to apply

Kaumātua details

1. Inoa/name.
2. Name you wish to go on tohu/certificate.
3. Kainga noho/Address.
4. Daytime contact waea/phone number.
5. Roopu/employer.
6. To mahi/Job title, full/part-time and brief description.
7. Name, address and daytime contact phone number for:

- dapaanz registered addiction practitioner or recognised member.
 - local iwi/hapū or recognised iwi/hapū urban authority.
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- Please provide details 1-7.
 - Submit a letter from the person applying.
 - Submit supporting letter from local hapū or iwi, or from a recognised hapū or iwi authority.
 - Submit a supporting letter from the dapaanz registered practitioner.
